She has 65 living descendants, among whom are listed 22 grandchildren, 37 great grandchildren, and five great-grandchildren.

In 1633 the first church ever built in New Amsterdam was constructed to replace the loft services. This church, facing the East River, was a plain wooden building, with a gambrel roof and no spire, on a lane that is now Pearl Street.

Nearly ten years later, it was replaced by a stone church built within the walls of the Fort. The church's spire and weathercock towered over the walls of the fort, so that they were the first sight seen as ships sailed into the harbor of New Amsterdam. This church, however, was in time taken over by the British to serve as a military garrison. To replace it, the Garden Street Church was built in 1693, in what is now Exchange Place.

LOUIS DU BOIS

Out of much that has been written and from what has been more recently discovered by investigation concerning this interesting and influential ancestor of the Van Metre family of America the following record has been compiled for this work.

Louis du Bois, a French Huguenot, was born 28th October, 1626, in La Bassee, near Lille, in the Province of Artois, France. He died at Kingston, Ulster County, N. Y., ----- 1696 [will proved 27th March, 1696]; was m. at Mannheim in the Lower Palatinate of Germany, 10th October, 1655, to Catharine, daughter, of Mathese Blanchan [a co-refugee with the du Bois from French Flanders] of Wicres, Artois [or Marseilles], France.

Mrs. Anna Louise Thompson, of Clinton, Iowa, a lineal descendant of the above Louis du Bois, in connection with M. Le Turcq, of the Genealogical Institute of Paris, has developed the du Bois line of ancestors running back to the days of the Scyrii, and includes descent from Charlemagne, Emperor of the West; Alfred the Great; Hugh Capet, King of France, and Henry I., Emperor of Germany. A chart has been worked out showing the most important of these lines, the correctness of which, Mrs. Thompson avers, has been verified by comparison with different sources of information; and where the line is broken, the cause is attributed to the summary action of Louis XIV.'s minister, Cardinal Mazarin, and Marshall Turenne, who decreed that the names of many of the noble families of the realm who espoused and held to the faith of Protestantism should be erased from the rolls and the documentary history of France and their property be confiscated. Such, then, was the law in respect to all "heretics." Mrs. Thompson further adds that Louis du Bois was a second son; that the titles and arms of de Fiennes were revived and that he assumed them, and that the line de Fiennes became extinct with the death of the Marchioness de Poyanne in 1761.

The first line in the chart begins with Guelph, Prince of the Scyrii (A. D. 476) ; a descendant of his in the fourteenth generation, Azo, Marquis of Liguria (A. D. 1030), married Marie, a descendant of the powerful house of Este in Italy. The Estes were of the Actii of Rome, who settled in Ital5j and Lombardy about 500 B. C.

#### Du Bois Homestead "The Old Fort"

The "Fort" built in compliance with Gov. Edmund Andros' order was to be used "for a place of Retreat and Safeguard". Although there are three gun ports on the ground floor, it is said no shots were ever fired from them against Indians.

The iron figures on the outside wall suggest the Fort was built in 1705. An early description sites it as "an old fashioned one story house with a basement". The 1798 tax list indicated a one and one half story stone dwelling. In the 1830's the house evolved into the current two story structure with garret. The eighteenth century jamless fireplace is converted to a jammed fireplace. The two story, four bay porch verandas are added.

Until the 1920's the Fort was lived in by DuBois family members or rented as a home to local New Paltz people. In the '20's it became a tearoom, and then in the '30s a restaurant run by Elsie Hannah Oates. Alice Crans, in 1976 continued the operation of this homestyle restaurant until retirement in 1990.

The Fort now houses the gift shop of the Huguenot Historical society and an exhibition room for visitors. In 2000 the DBFA helped HHS fund an Historic Structures Report that recommends an effective planning framework for appropriate restoration of the building port.

The HHS through its endowment for the Fort, and the writing of grants and the DBFA through fund raising together ensure that the building will be conserved and restored.

DuBois Family History

The DuBois family of New Paltz, NY are descendants of Chretien DuBois (b.1597) and his wife Cornelia (name uncertain). He was a prosperous middle class linen merchant and devout protestant from the village of Wicres, outside of Lille. In 1659 the area was handed over by the Catholic Spanish Netherlands to the Catholic regime of Louis XIV, who imposed high taxes on the middle classes and cruelly persecuted the Protestant (Huguenot) dissidents.

Chretien was the father of five children: Francoise (b.1622), Anne (b.1624), Louis (b.1626-d.1696), Jacques (b.1628-d.1676) and another son, name unknown.

Resentful of high taxes and fearful of religious persecution, Francoise and Jacques settled in Leyden, Holland. Meanwhile, Louis along with other Huguenot refugees moved to Mannheim, Germany (near Heidelberg) on the Rhine River. This area was called die Pfalz (hence the origin later of the village name of New Paltz).

While in Germany, Louis DuBois married another French Huguenot, Catherine Blanchan in 1655. They emigrated to America in 1660 and traveled ninety miles up the Hudson River to a small community in the Kingston - Hurley area where he obtained a land grant in 1663.

Francoise, and her husband Pierre Billiou also emigrated in 1660, settling in Staten Island, NY. Fourteen years later Jacques and his wife, Pierrone Bentyn arrived in Kingston.

In the 1660's during the "Esopus Wars", there were many hostile incidents between white settlers and the Esopus Indians. During these times in 1663 a raid killed 21 people and Catherine Blanchan DuBois and her three children were carried off and held captive for three months before being rescued by a contingent of Dutch soldiers. During this expedition to rescue his wife tradition has it that Louis DuBois discovered the beautiful Walkill valley which became his new home.

Jacques children spread across the Hudson River and helped establish the Fishkill and Poughkeepsie. The children of Louis married the offspring of other patentees of New Paltz which gradually grew into a small self governing village. One daughter, Sarah, married a Van Meter and moved to New Jersey and then farther south. This branch of DuBoises helped open the way west and contributed to the settling of Kentucky and West Virginia.

The DuBoises, and other Huguenot families of New Paltz, were slave owners. Louis purchased two slaves at public auction in Kingston 1674. The 1755 census shows Solomon DuBois as owning seven slaves.

The DuBois family takes some small comfort that Catherine DuBois Cottin (Louis DuBois widow) made specific mention in her 1712 will that a manumission letter written for her slave girl Rachel in 1709 shall "remain in force and be properly observed".

Perhaps another counter balance to that history is that W.E.B. DuBois, a founding director of the NAACP and editor of The Crisis from 1910-1934, dedicates his autobiography to his great grandfather Dr. James DuBois, a physician in Poughkeepsie, who he claims is descended from Jacques in the fifth generation. DuBois in his nineties, discouraged by the inability of capitalism to bring the highest welfare to its people, believed in communism.

Some descendants do not like having that connection, and would rather celebrate relationship with other famous branches of the family tree: General George Patton, artist Mary Cassatt, actor Marlon Brando and actress Joan Crawford.
