I am told his wife was Jennie Martha McClenden, and that she died there in Oct., 1879, so she is probably on the 1880 Mortality Schedule. He died there on 30 July 1881. His son Dennis W. King (b. 21 October 1850, GA; d. 25 December 1922) and family were living with him in 1880. I am in contact with a descendant of this Dennis W. King and can eliminate his family. The following is the deed from Ambrose Huffman to Son Henry, Sept. 6, 1836:

This Indenture made and ordered into between Ambrose Huffman of Barren County and the State of Kentucky of the one part and Henry Huffman of same County and State of the other part----- that said Ambrose Huffman for and in consideration of the sum of two dollars lawfull money in hand paid the receipt of whichis hereby acknowledged have bargained & sold by their presents doth bargain and sell unto the aforesaid Henry Huffman one certain parcel or track of land situated on the waters of Nobob Creek supposed to contain one road fourteen poles and eighty eight hundredth to be the same on leps and bounded as follows-----beginning at a rock thence North 32 degrees West 11 poles to a cycamore on the bank of said creek thence South 62 degrees East 15 poles to a rock thence South 72 West 8 poles to the beginning appurtences to have and to hold the foresaid track or parcel of land as described unto said Henry Huffman his heirs and -----forever and the said Ambrose Huffman for himself and his heirs do by their presents conveyant and agree to warrant and forever defend unto the said Henry Huffman & his heirs the aforesaid track or parcel of land with all the appurtances thereunto belonging against the claims of all and every person or persons whomever.

BIOGRAPHY: Nehemiah migrated to Houston County by way of Virginia to Rockingham County, South Carolina and then to Jones County, Georgia with his father. Nehemiah moved to Houston County just after the county was formed in 1821. Nehemiah lived from 1829-1840 in Houston County Land District 5, lot number 241. This lot is located at the intersection of Russell Parkway and Georgia Highway 247, which is on the southwest side of Robins AFB approximately in the section now housing bldg 640 and 645.

Nehemiah's will is recorded Houston County Will Book "A" page 146-147. His will was written in 1840 and listed 12 children.

William Woodward served in the Bedford County Militia, in 1758. On June 25, 1765, he bought from his older brother- Isaac Woodward, a tract of land on Ivy Creek, in Bedford County, Virginia. Fifteen years later, on March 8, 1780, he and his wife, Sarah, sold this land, which contained 100 acres, to his brother-in-law, William Hall (husband of Urcilla Woodward) for 1,000 pounds. Richard Woodward was probably named by his mother, Elizabeth (Cocke) Woodward, as a namesake of his maternal great-uncle, Richard Cocke, "the younger," and/or his maternal great-grandfather, Lt. Col. Richard Cocke, of "Bremo," Henrico Co., Virginia. After her father died, Elizabeth Cocke, yet an infant, was taken in by her Uncle Richard Cocke, until she was of age or married to Lancelot Woodward, so it seems quite fitting that she would have named her first-born son after the uncle to whom she owed such a debt of gratitude.

In the "Executive Journals of the Council of Virginia, Volume V," on pages 235-236, appears the following:

At a Council held May 7, 1747, . . . The following petitions for land were granted: . . .
To Richard Woodward 1800 acres in Albemarle, lying on the branches of the Fluvanna River, beginning on the lands belonging to Nicholas Davies or Thomas Jones, on or near Ivy Creek or its branches near Flemings Mountains. . . .

This was not a patent or land grant, but merely gave Richard Woodward permission to seek and obtain land there. His father, Lancelot Woodward, died ca. 1749/50 and, about a year or so later, on February 6, 1751, Richard Woodward witnessed a deed of sale for 200 acres of land in Albemarle Co., from Francis Calloway and his wife, Frances, to John Thomson; other witnesses were Edward Bright, James Callaway, James Fair, and Edmund Fair, all of whom seem to have been closely associated with Richard Woodward's family for many years. Several weeks later, on March 29, 1751, Richard Woodward and all of the witnesses named above were mentioned again in a series of deeds, in which most of them acquired land of their own from Nicholas Davies, for example:

Nicholas Davies, Gent., of Cumberland Co., to Richard Woodward, of Albemarle Co., for 58 Pounds, 1 shilling, & 3 pence, 800 acres on the Branches of Blackwater, near Fleming's Mountain. Wit: John Anthony, Edward Bright, James Callaway, James Fair, and Edmund Fair.

George Woodward was first mentioned in the court records of Isle of Wight County, Virginia, as a witness to the will of George Hardy, March 16, 1654. Among others mentioned in the same will, was Justinian Cooper who had claimed a William Woodward as a headright, March 16, 1642. Nearly two years later, on January 15, 1656, another court record in Surry County showed the following: "George Woodward signed and sworn in court, Surry County, William Hukins his account. 5 months diett for his wife. Charge of burial and a sheete."

Then, some years later, on April 9, 1670, another court record in Isle of Wight County said: "Robert Bythesae, 26 years of age, 'showeth that, when Mr. John Clay sent for deponent, he was in company with Mr. Hardy, John Clay, Jr., and Mr. Woodward. George Hardy, aged 37, deposed. John Clay, Jr., aged 25, deposed.' "

In October 1670, an executors' squabble to be settled in the General Court in James City County said that Thomas Harris's widow and executrix, Alice, brought suit against the late George Woodward's estate. In 1676, George Woodward was second to sign a "Memorial of Grievances" (petition), from James City County. About one year later, in 1677, he patented 2,000 acres of land, in James City County, "in Wimbleton (Wilmington) Parish, and upon Tyascun (Diascund) Swamp," which had been granted to Sir John Ayton, October 15, 1653.

In the Quit Rent Roll of 1704, the same 2,000 acre plantation, mentioned above, was divided up, as follows: Lancelot Woodward (650 acres, John Woodward (650 acres), George Woodward (350 acres), and Samuel Woodward (350), perhaps four sons of the George Woodward mentioned above.

Christopher Woodward emigrated from England to Virginia on the ship- "Tryall," in June of 1620, just six months prior to the landing of the Mayflower at Plymouth Rock, in December of 1620. He came ashore at Jamestown and, two years later, somehow miraculously survived the great Indian Massacre of 1622. Two years later, in 1624/5, he was commissioned to be the head of a Muster at West and Shirley hundred, in Charles City County. In 1625, he was living at his "nowe dwelling house," at Shirley hundred, in Charles City County, with his first wife- Margaret. In 1629, he was serving as the Burgess from Westover, Charles City County. By 1637, he had amassed a plantation of 600 acres of land in Charles City County. During that period of time, 1630-35, his first wife- Margaret apparently died and he married (2nd) Dorothy Wilkinson, daughter of Richard Wilkinson of Isle of Wight County.
